**“Helping the Kids Play” at Kids America
Scholarship Program
Policies**

Some children may be unable to participate in recreation programs due to economic hardship. Kids America’s “Helping the Kids Play” scholarship program provides financial assistance to reduce certain fees and charges.

1. Need is the primary criterion upon which applications are considered.
2. An application for a scholarship shall be submitted as early as possible before the program begins.
3. Each application must be accompanied by the following attachments:
 - a. Copy of the most recent federal tax return or other documentation of income.
 - b. Completed registration form for selected activity.
4. Kids America’s “Helping the Kids Play” scholarship program seeks contributions from individuals, social groups, clubs, businesses and service organizations to assist in providing financial assistance.
5. This program will not provide financial aid for programs which involve contracted services such as trips, performances, tickets or admissions.
6. Kids America and the Scholarship Committee reserve the right to limit the amount of financial aid awarded to an individual (\$75) during a one year period. The fiscal year for the scholarship program shall be August 1 to July 31.
7. All applicants must be residents of Coshocton County and under 18 years of age.
8. The total amount of the scholarship awarded will be based on income eligibility. Accepted scholarship applicants are expected to pay a minimum of \$10 or the balance of the program fee after the scholarship award.
9. A limited number of scholarships are available on an annual basis.

Scholarship Aid Process:

1. Applications will be received and processed by the Executive Director of Kids America and then forwarded to the Scholarship Committee for approval.
2. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
3. The Executive Director will contact the applicant with the decision of the committee.
